## 2020 Year End Award Circuit Rules

- Once a Rider/Horse Combination enters three of the shows that is part of the Oklahoma Eventing Circuit and fulfill the below requirements, they are eligible for year end awards. **Rider/Horse combinations must compete in 3 Oklahoma Eventing Circuit shows during that award year.** No fee to join the circuit.
- Champion and Reserve Champion prizes along with 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons** will be awarded to horse/ rider combinations based upon points earned during the calendar year at horse trials or combined tests held at the following facilities – Feather Creek Farm, Celtic Cross Equestrian Center and Southern Hills Riding Academy. Year End Awards will be given for the following divisions: Preliminary, Modified, Training, Senior Novice, Junior Novice, Sr Beginner Novice, Jr Beginner Novice, Sr Starter, Jr Starter, Sr Introductory, Jr Introductory, Sr Grasshopper, and Jr Grasshopper. The Junior and Senior divisions will be combined if less than six in each division for year end awards.
- An **Overall Rider of the Year Award for both Seniors and Juniors** will be awarded. This will include all points accumulated by a rider/horse combination. A rider/horse combination can move up or down only one division for points to count.
- Senior riders are 19 and over; Junior riders are 18 years old and under (age on January 1<sup>st</sup> of that year).
- Divisions Defined:** **Dressage** – Preliminary, Modified, Training, Novice, & Beg. Novice - Corresponding 2018 USEA tests, Starter, Introductory, & Grasshopper – Introductory Level dressage tests (walk/trot only); **Stadium Jumping** – Training – 3’3”, Novice-2’9”, Beg. Novice – 2’7”, Starter-2’4”, Introductory Level – 18” crossbars; Grasshopper Level-12” **Cross Country Jumping** – Training – 3’3”, Novice-2’9”, Beg. Novice – 2’7”, Starter-2’4”, Introductory Level– 2’ & Grasshopper Level—18”.
